ALL TRASH AND RECYCLING MUST BE PLACED CURBSIDE BY 7AM



Trash Weekly & Recycling Collection Schedule : Recyclables are collected every other week on your regular trash collection day. Place at curb separate from trash by 7 AM. Recycle week is highlighted.

Holiday Schedule : Whenever a scheduled collection day falls on a holiday, that day's collection and all remaining collections for the week will be delayed one day. Friday's collection will be on Saturday. Holidays are circled.

- Newspapers/inserts
- Magazines
- Paperboard, remove plastic liners (cereal, cracker boxes)
- Corrigated cardboard
- Phone books
- Brown paper bags
- Junk Mail
- Office Paper
- Milk Cartons and juice boxes
- **NO** waste paper, plastic coated paper or plastic bags

CONTAINERS

- Glass bottles/jars, all colors & sizes
- Aluminum/tin/steel cans and lids
- Aluminum foil/pie plates
- All plastic containers labeled 1-7
- Aseptic juice boxes
- **NO** broken glass or other items (e.g. window glass, dishes, glasses, Pyrex, ceramics, light bulbs)
- **NO** cans or bottles containing paint, aerosol or hazardous materials

Single stream recycle

NO PLASTIC BAGS or STYROFOAM in RECYCLING
Return plastic bags to your grocery store.
No TRASH is allowed in Recycling!

- Newspapers/ inserts
- Office, note and copy paper
- Junk mail, phone books and magazines – Remove cellophane, foil & wrappings.
- Chipboard– Cereal, shoe, cracker boxes, etc., remove plastic liners.
- Corrugated cardboard– Flatten, size to 2' x 2' or smaller and bundle.
- All paper and cardboard must be clean.

No foil, wax, cellophane or Styrofoam mixed with cardboard.

- Deposit and non-deposit beverage and aerosol cans, jars and bottles made of glass, metal, or plastic #1-5, & 7
- Food, beverage, soap, and household cleaning containers
- Aluminum foil and trays
- Milk cartons and juice boxes
- Leave on caps and rings from all containers. Labels may be left on. Crush plastic bottles.
- Empty aerosol cans.

No light bulbs, window glass, dishes, glasses, and Pyrex.
No paint cans, unmarked plastic or Styrofoam packing.
No plastic bags– Return to grocery store.

Note: Think of function (cans, bottles, jars, etc.) and not what the item is made of. Light bulbs, hub caps, plastic toys, etc. are all non recyclable.

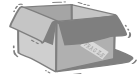

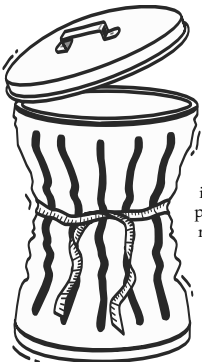
